UPON REVIEW of Florida Statute §28.223 and Florida Statute §734.1025, as well as other provisions of the Florida Statutes and the applicable Probate Rules, it is hereby ORDERED:

1. Effective upon entry of this Order, the following documents shall be recorded in Official Records of the Offices of the Clerks of the Courts in Hardee, Highlands and Polk Counties, Florida, under the provisions of Florida Statutes 28.223,:

- A. Wills and Codicils Admitted to Probate
- B. Orders Revoking Probate of any Wills and Codicils
- C. Letters of Administration
- D. Petitions and Orders Affecting or Describing Real Property
- E. Orders and Certificates of Distribution Pertaining to Real Property
- F. Final Orders
- G. Final Orders of Final Discharge
- H. Authenticated Transcripts of Pertinent Foreign Proceedings, only those portions
- I. Disclaimers
- J. Orders determining Elective Share
- K. Non-Taxable Certificates and Final Tax Certificates
- L. Estate Tax Closing Letters of the Internal Revenue Service or other Evidence of Payment
- M. Such other papers as the Court may specifically direct, in writing, to be recorded.

The recording fees for the recording of all the above documents shall be included in the filing fee paid upon the opening of the Guardianship proceedings.


3. Effective upon entry of this Order, the sum of \$25.00 shall be added to the filing fees due to the Probate Department on the filing of the following probate matters:

- F. Ancillary Administration
- G. Curator and Conservator Proceeding

4. All other documents may be recorded in the Official Records of the Offices of the Clerks only upon payment of the recording fee described in Florida Statute §28.24 and other applicable provisions of the Florida Statutes.

5. This Order revokes and supercedes Administrative Order No. 4-1.1 entered September 29, 1994.
